Built in 1799 along the Delaware River, the Historic Lazaretto is the oldest surviving quarantine facility in the Western Hemisphere. Wu & Associates preserved and reproduced building elements for 20,000 square feet of space, providing for the adaptive reuse of the building for township administration functions. The work entailed an overhaul of utility systems, reconstruction of the porch, restoration of masonry, wood windows, plaster, woodwork, a cupola and weathervane, an upgraded elevator system, new steel beams to increase the load capacity of the building, reproduction of hardware using the traditional method of hand forging, repointing of the exterior brick with a conventional hydraulic lime-based mortar that contained no cement, and adding a mostly ductless variable refrigerant frequency environmental control system. At the event to receive the award were members of the Wu & Associates team; Kirby Wu, President, Katherine Ng, Vice President, Adrian Salcedo, Business Development Manager, Reginald (Reg) DeJesus, Office Administrator, and Monica Bayruns, Accounting Assistant alongside Tony Rader, 2019 ABC National Chairman.
